Powder coating - Unwrap it. Don't trap it.

When you receive your powder coated item, Unwrap it.

Your powder coated item will come wrapped in Plastic Stretch Film and/or paper, foam, or cardboard. Plastic Stretch Film is used to protect the surface of the item while it is in transit and to keep the package tightly together.

On receipt of your delivery, if you cannot store the package indoors, we strongly recommend you unwrap the item and dispose of the Plastic Stretch Film.

Rainwater, humid conditions, condensation, and / or moisture trapped between the plastic wrap and the surface of the item, can cause the plastic wrap to transfer polymers to the powder coated surface compromising the finish.

On some occasions this reaction can be treated to revive the even tone and colour, however the item often requires recoating.

Any remedy including re- powder coating, deinstallation, collection and delivery required to treat an object affected by the issue outlined above are considered additional works and will be charged to the client.

Powder coating is resilient, durable and assists in maintaining the integrity of the material beneath and most importantly, your powder coated item has been designed and fabricated to live outdoors.

Unwrap it. Don't trap it. Remove the Plastic Stretch Film and avoid the cost of recoating.
